They both welcomed all eleven of us and gave us permission to use their shed to cook our food.

City are always full of hustle and bustle. Even during night time, the city never sleeps. There will be always mob of peoples, honking of the vehicles and unrestful lives. In this ten hours, we have walked in the path that was never been tread before living behind the every last village, odyssey covered with several creeks, waterfalls and the enthralling scenery that motivates us to elevate more higher. Solitude, no more cacophony of urban life, only eleven of us and the forest. It was all mesmerizing when the day was bright and we could see the green appearance of the place but as soon as the sun sets down, and green turns into pitch dark, the thrill and the real adventure begin which I was always willing to experience. 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
























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
