LBEF team Er. Prakash Kumar Kejriwal (Executive Director), Dr. Sandeep Kautish (Dean-Academics) and Mr. Jasbir Singh (IT Officer) visited Infomax College of Information Technology and Management for two (02) days on 8-9 July 2022.

In the series of various sessions, the first session was conducted by Er. Prakash Kumar Kejriwal who briefed about the Asia Pacific University of Technology and Innovation, Malaysia, and its teaching pedagogies i.e. Outcome-based Education, employability, and skills. He also explained how Education 4.0 has merged with Industry 4.0 and needs skilled manpower. Two different Turnitin Awareness Sessions were delivered to all Infomax students to make them aware about the possible cause of plagiarism and how to avoid it. It was followed by a session on how to access APUSpace and use the login credentials to access various academic and non-academic resources i.e. 11 online libraries, teaching, and research materials from Moodle. After that, students were made aware about IR and FYP requirements i.e. PPF and PSF-related queries of students were answered and detailed procedures were explained.

One session was conducted for all the faculty members of Infomax College to make them aware of Turnitin and how to deal with similarity index cases while evaluating students' assignments, tests, and exam scripts. During this session, Er. Prakash Kumar Kejriwal conveyed the



concerns raised by APU related to the delay of result dispatch and informed all faculty members and staff about the new yearly planner of progression board dates and requested all to adhere to the same from all future cohorts. The session was quite interactive and faculty members asked their questions related to academic matters i.e. self-plagiarism, test components and their evaluation time etc. The session was well received and applauded by all participants.

With delicacies taste that lingers through the year


Fifteen days of worship and admiration
